## **Pupil Attendance at Limehurst Primary School - Spring Term 1**



Improving pupil attendance remains a key focus for the Spring Term. We're encouraged by the positive impact of our ongoing Attendance Improvement Project and are pleased to report an increase in attendance at the end of the Autumn Term, compared with the same period in 2023. While we've not yet met the national target of 95%, we are steadily moving in the right direction.

Although there has been a decrease in the overall number of sessions missed by our pupils, we have observed a rise in the number of pupils arriving late to school through the school office.

This means that since September, we have had a total 2,396 sessions recorded as late!

We kindly ask all parents to make a concerted effort in the new year to ensure that pupils arrive at school on time and access their class via their usual entrance door. We hope that, with the cooperation of all parents and carers, we will see a significant reduction in the number of pupils arriving late in the new vear.



## Attendance Achievements



53 pupils achieved 100% attendance during the Autumn term and were entered into our termly attendance prize draw. Each Key Stage had the opportunity for one child to win a shopping voucher. Congratulations to our winners, Joshua in Class 6 and Damian in Class 8, and to all 53 attendance champions who have attended school every day this term!

The winning class with the best overall attendance for the Autumn Term was Class 9 with 97%
